








The IES planning committee obtained the following data from the service providers and IES sponsors, showing the impact of IES since 2012:

- As of November 1, 2013, there were 115 new companies formed in Iowa by IES attendees. Both Governor Branstad and Lt. Governor Reynolds signed the Congratulations Certificates for each of these companies.
- Over the past five years, IES has helped Summit Participants create more than 575 new businesses.





At the 2013 IES, there were **507** participants who migrated to lowa from 44 countries. IES was attended by **471** people in 2012, **468** people in 2011, **425** people in 2010, **350** people in 2009, and **300** people in 2008.

Since the first IES in 2008, collectively the Summit has generated more than **575** new businesses across the midwest. There were **115** new companies formed by 2012 attendees.
